Privacy Policy

This privacy policy describes how we handle your personal information received and collected through the Pulse Web Site (the "Site"). By accepting the Privacy Policy and the Conditions of Use Agreement through your use of this Site and/or in registration of an account or other use of this Site, you expressly consent to our collection, storage, use and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy. COLLECTION

Once you give us your personal information, you are not anonymous to us. USE

measure, and improve our services and the Site's content and layout; tell you about targeted marketing, service updates, and promotional offers; and compare information for accuracy, and verify it with third parties; and for any other purpose as may be set forth in this Privacy Policy or in the Conditions of Use as amended from time to time.

OUR DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may disclose personal information to respond to legal requirements, enforce our policies, respond to claims that a listing or other content violates the rights of others, or protect anyone's rights, property, or safety. We may also share your personal information with: members of our corporate family to help detect and prevent potentially illegal acts and provide joint services; law enforcement or other governmental officials, in response to a verified request relating to a criminal investigation or alleged illegal activity (In such events we will disclose name, city, state, telephone number, and email address); and other business entities, should we plan to merge with, or be acquired by that business entity. App Ads Marketing and any related entity or individual shall not be liable under any circumstances for any disclosure of any kind whether intentional or unintentional.

COOKIES

We use cookies (small files placed on your hard drive) on certain pages of the Site to help analyze our web page flow, customize our services, and measure promotional effectiveness.

You may encounter cookies from third parties on certain pages of the Site that we do not control. (For example, if you view a web page created by another user, there may be a cookie placed by that web page.) We are not responsible for cookies placed by web sites not under our control and any information obtained by such cookies.

ACCOUNT PROTECTION

If you have registered on this Site for an account, your password is the key to your account to protect the information you provided. Use unique numbers, letters, and special characters and do not disclose your App Ads Marketing password to anyone. If you do share your password or personal information with others, remember that you are responsible for all actions taken in the name of your account.
